Abstract

Abstract art uses a visual language of form, color and line to create a composition which may exist with a degree of independence from visual references in the world.



American

American art encompasses the history of painting and visual art in the United States. In the late eighteenth and early nineteenth centuries, artists primarily painted landscapes and portraits in a realistic style.



Animals

An animal painter is an artist who specializes in or is known for their skill in the portrayal of animals, essentially up to about 1900. During the last century "wildlife artist" became the preferred term for contemporary animal painters.



Contemporary

Contemporary is art produced at this present point in time or art produced since World War II.



European

European art is art produced by contemporary and historic artists trained in Europe.



Expressionism

Expressionism was a modernist movement, initially in poetry and painting, originating in Germany at the beginning of the 20th century. Its presents the world solely from a subjective perspective, distorting it radically for emotional effect in order to evoke moods or ideas.



Figurative

Figurative art describes artwork, particularly paintings and sculptures, which are clearly derived from real object sources, and are therefore by definition representational.



Hispanic

The art has roots in many different indigenous cultures that inhabited the Americas before the European colonization in the 16th century. The indigenous cultures each developed sophisticated artistic disciplines, highly influenced by religious and spiritual concerns.



Impressionism

Impressionism was a 19th-century art movement that originated with a group of Paris-based artists whose independent exhibitions brought them to prominence during the 1870s and 1880s.




Landscapes

Landscape art depicts natural scenery such as mountains, valleys, trees, rivers, and forests, and especially art where the main subject is a wide view, with its elements arranged into a coherent composition.
