

texcalc converts from one tex unit to another

Synopsis

```
texcalc [options] [n.m]unit1 [unit2]
```

Options:

```
-s,--scale    number of decimal places in the output
-h,--help     print this help and exit
-H,--Help     print full documentation via less and exit
-V,--version  print version and exit
```

Description

texcalc converts [an amount of] TeX units to another TeX unit. The default for the last is `pt`. Known units are:

```
bp cc cm dd in mm pc pt
```

Examples

These print 25.40000mm:

```
texcalc in mm
texcalc lin mm
texcalc 1.0in mm
```

The default output unit is `pt`, so this prints 1.00375pt:

```
texcalc bp
```
