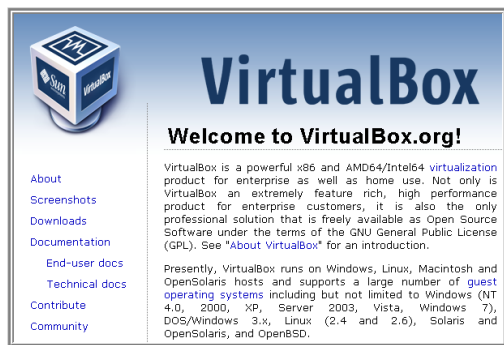


# How To Install Virtual Box

On a Windows PC

## Introduction

Sun's Virtual Box is a software program able to create an additional virtual computer within your real one.



Thus you can browse the web with a virtual PC and no virus can harm your real computer.

Virtual Box is free for personal and commercial use.

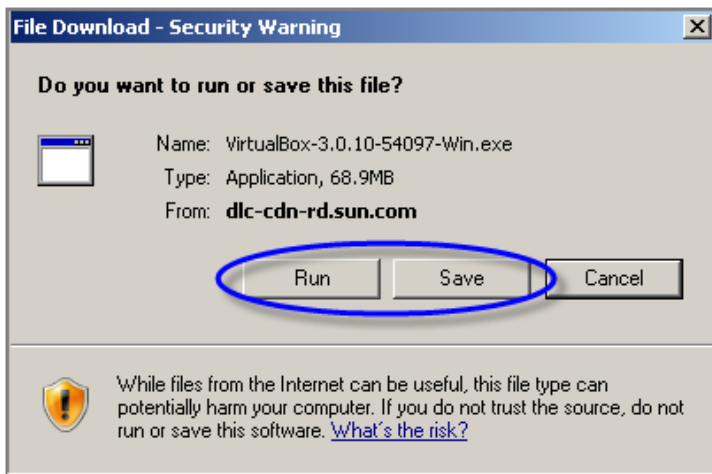

## Download

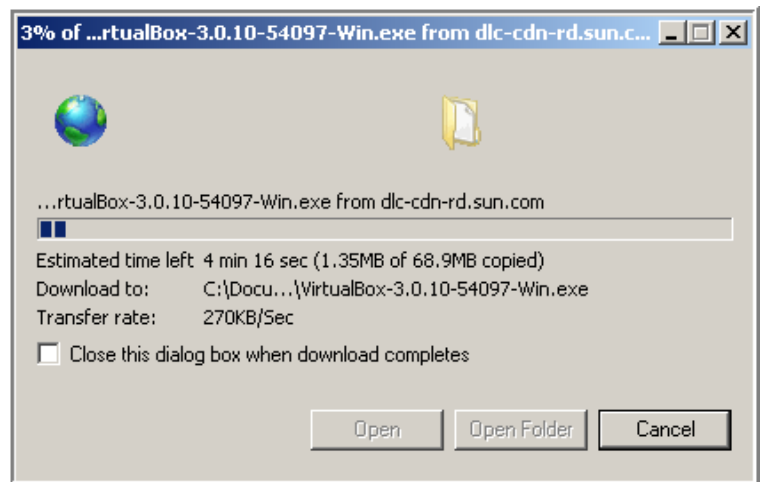
Visit their [Download-Page](#) and download **x86/amd64**

if you got Windows7, Vista or XP as main operating system

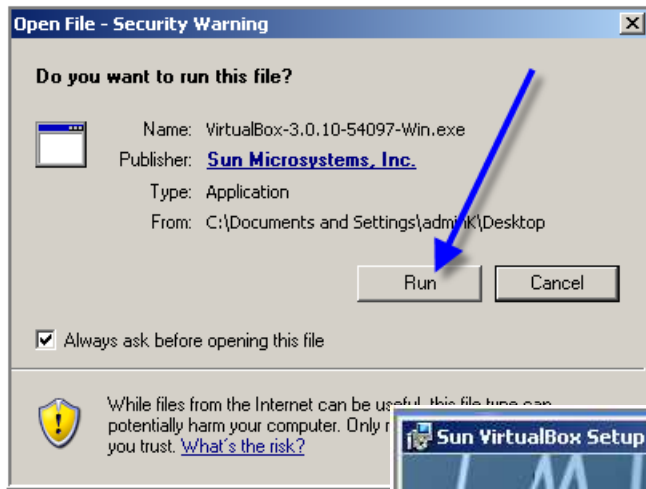


**'Run'**

The download will take about four minutes when using a DSL connection.

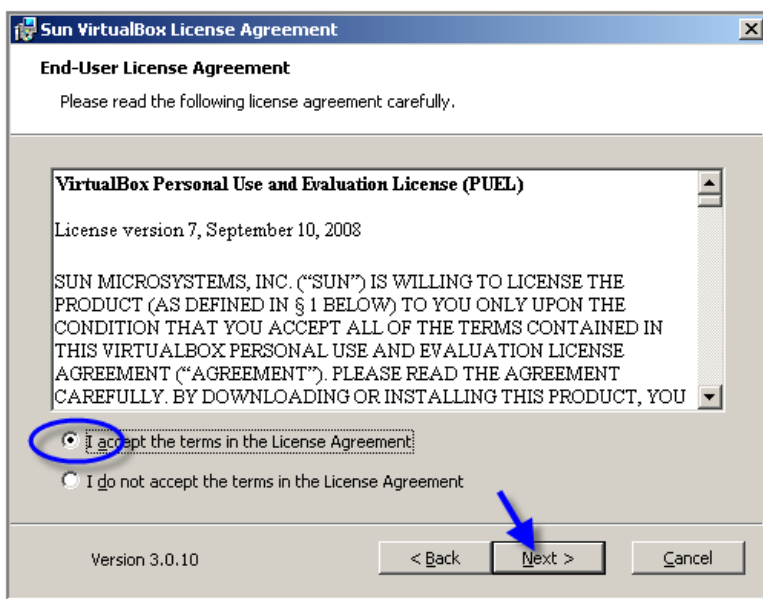
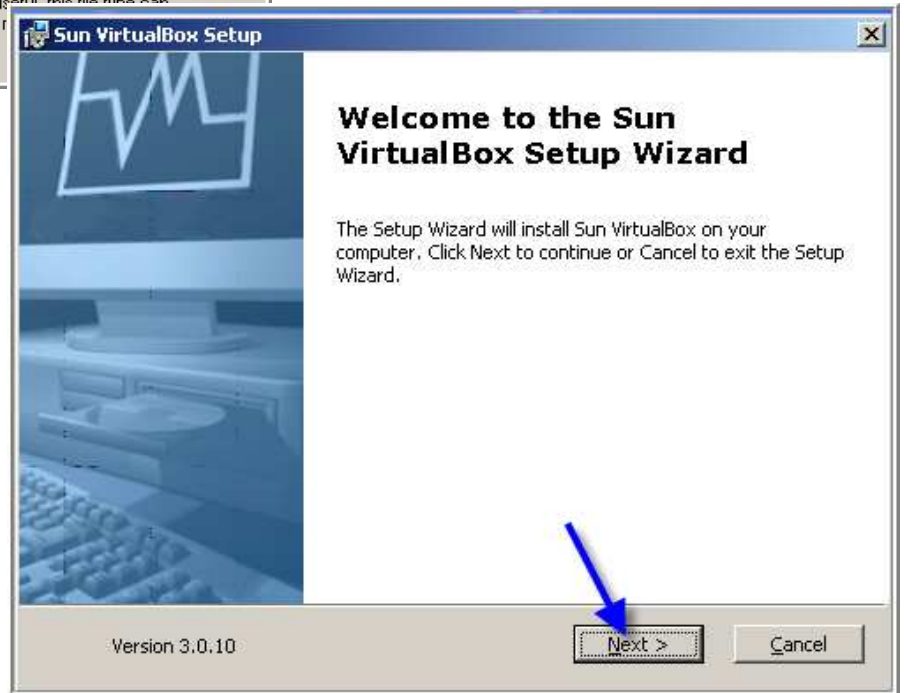

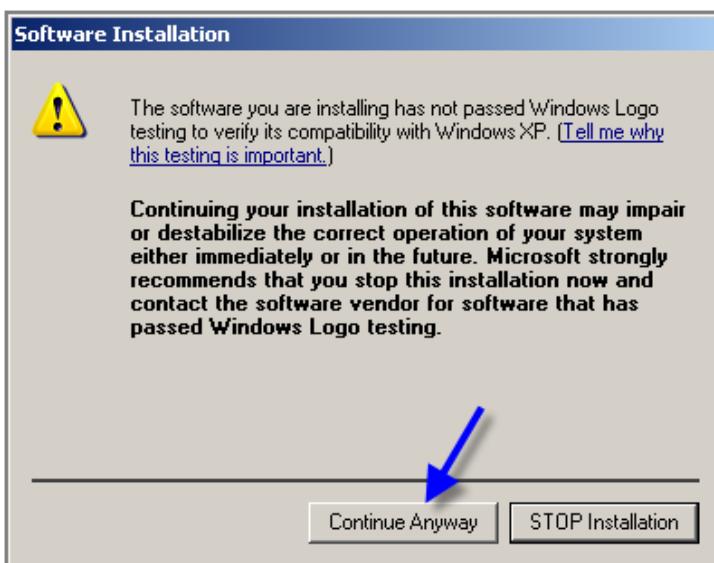
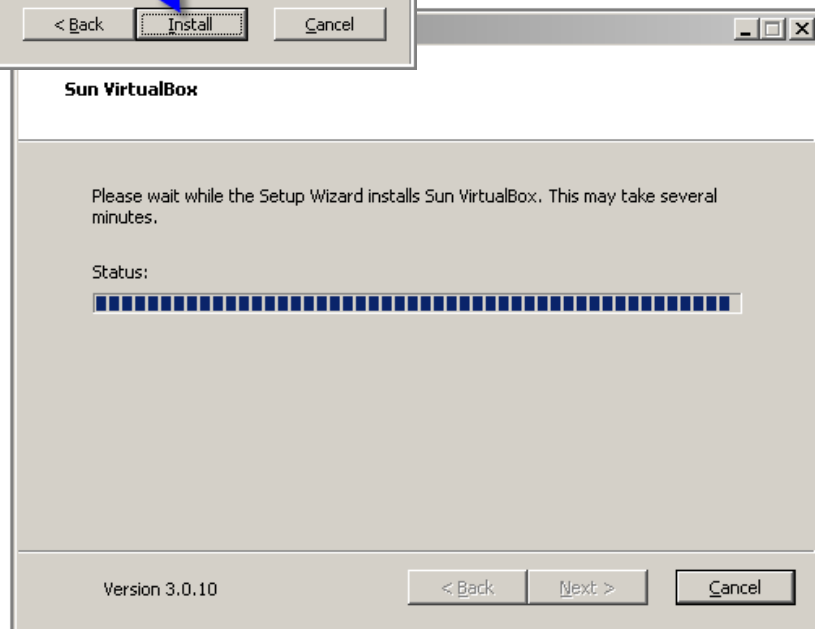
Be prepared that your network will be switched off/on and go on with 'Yes'

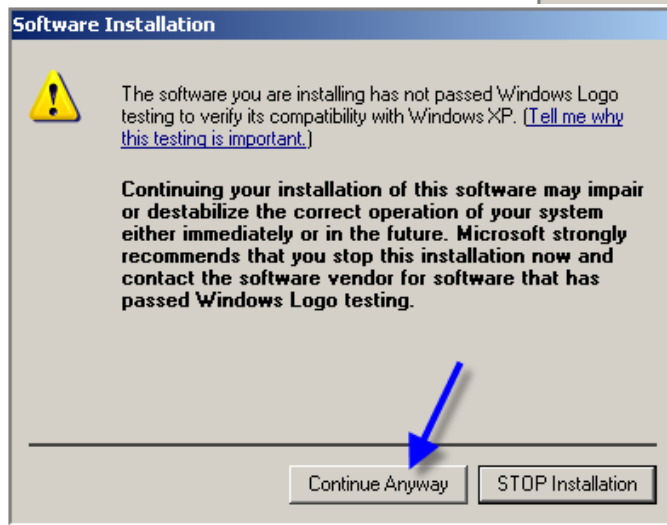
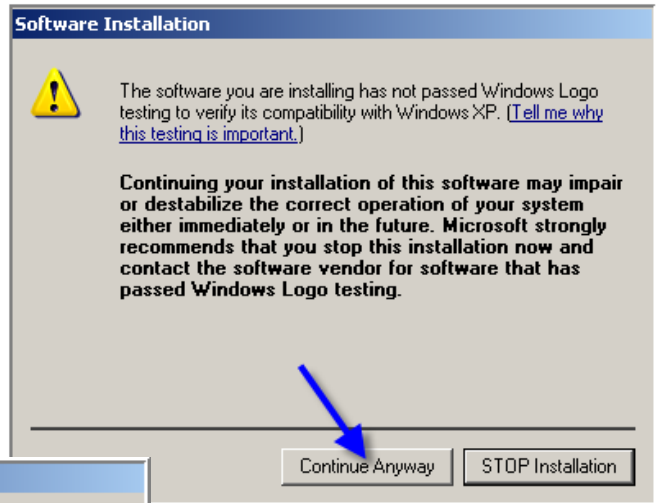

Now you'll get a series of warnings by which Microsoft tries to stop Non-Microsoft software.

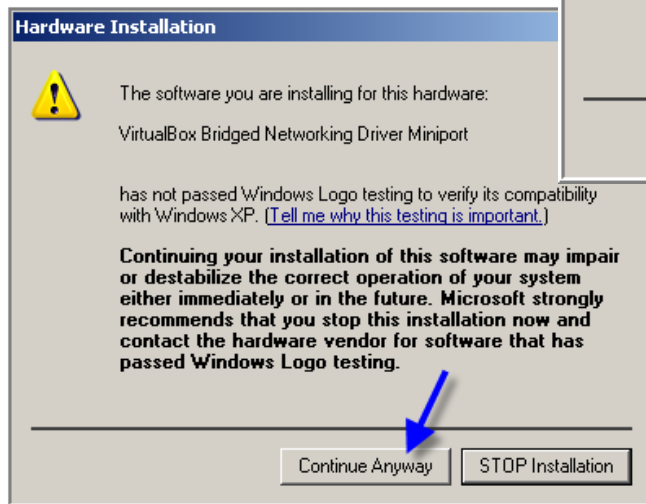
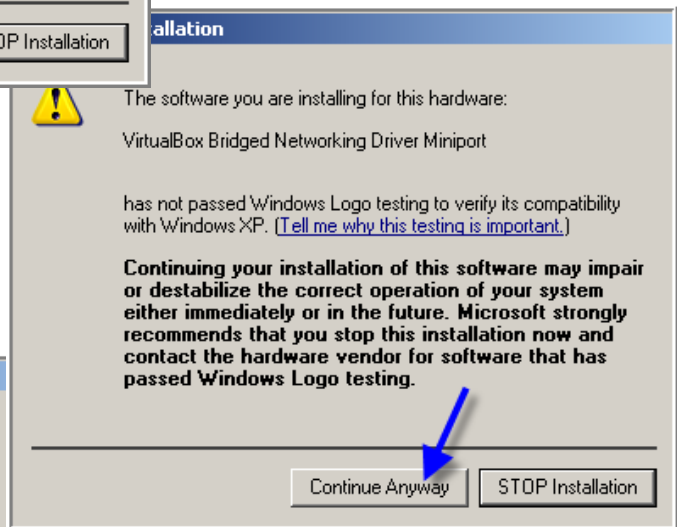
As Sun is a trustworthy publisher don't care for these warnings and hit **'Continue Anyway'**.

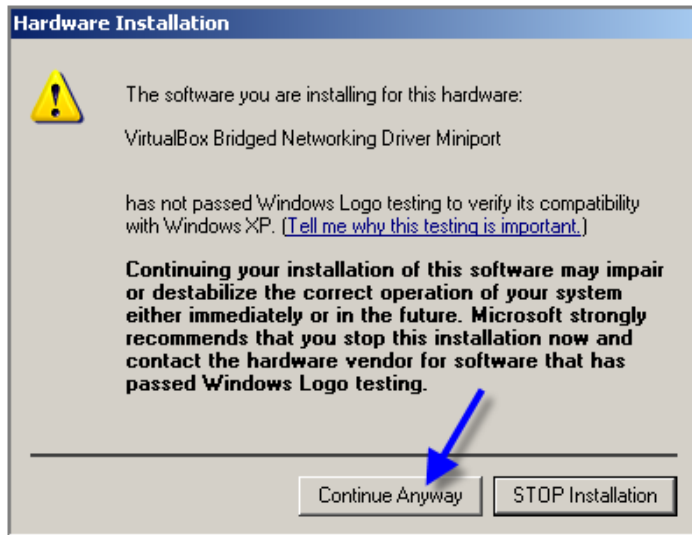

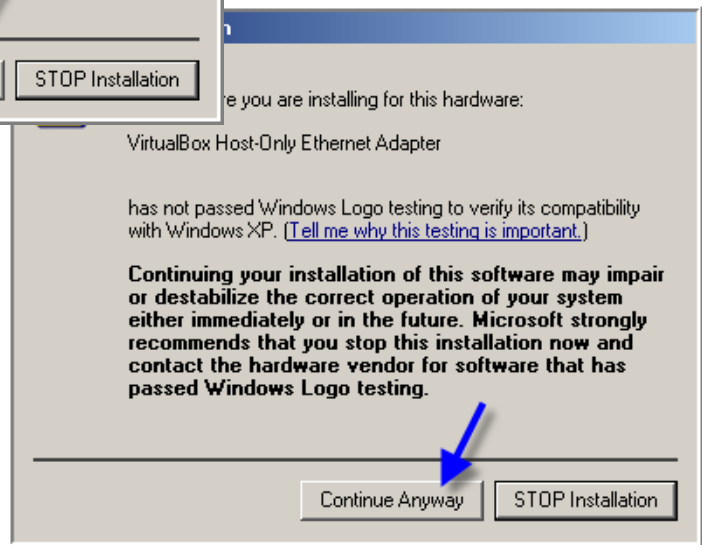

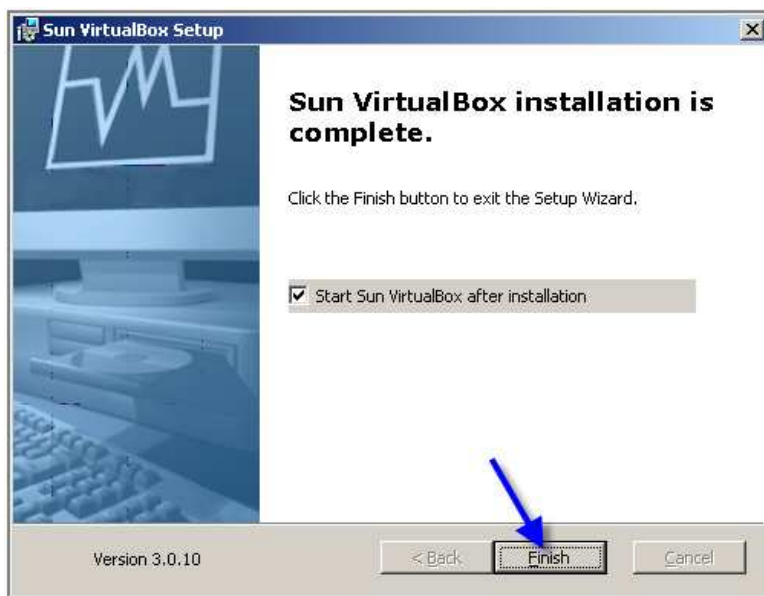

After about two minutes waiting, finally you get the success message:

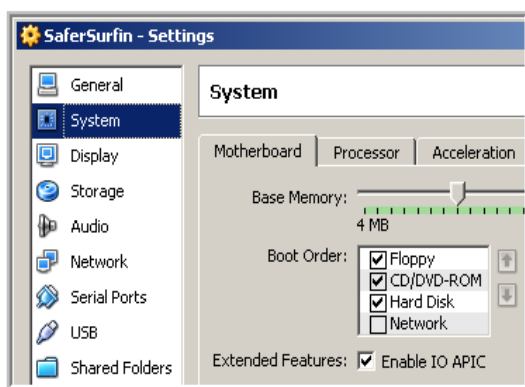
**Sun's Virtual Box Installation is complete.**

Hit **'Finish'** to leave the setup.

## Next Steps

Now you are ready to start Virtual Box.

Enter Welcome screen and you get ...



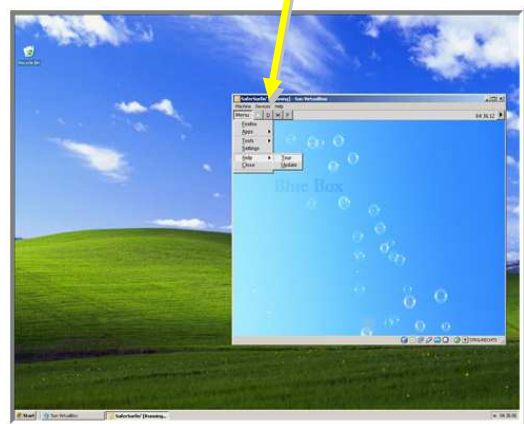
## A Second PC

with:

- Internet** using the network of your 1<sup>st</sup> PC
- Hard Disk** stored as VDI file on your 1<sup>st</sup> PC
- Display** using a window of your 1<sup>st</sup> PC

The 2<sup>nd</sup> PC has to be set up the same way as your 1<sup>st</sup> PC had. That can be done with your Windows Installation CD.

Better download a ready made Bluebox Disk and you get a working 2<sup>nd</sup> PC within minutes<sup>1</sup>.



BlueBox will operate your 2<sup>nd</sup> PC from the top bar easier than Windows could do as explained in the next Guide.
