Introduction

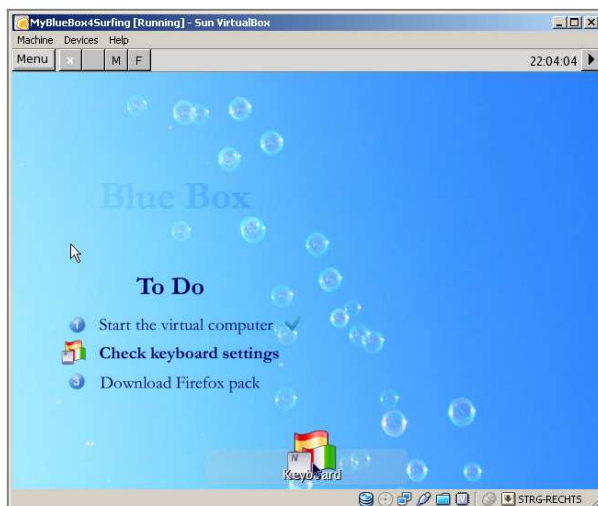
After installing¹ Sun's Virtual Box and
downloading² a BlueBox Hard Disk
you got a working 2nd PC.

Probably you may want additional software
like the Firefox browser or change the default
setting to a Non-US keyboard.



Both is integrated in the automatic setup sequence of the downloaded BlueBox disk.

Setting Keyboard



When first starting³ the downloaded BlueBox disk
you are offered the keyboard setting screen.

Click the keyboard button
and follow the the auto-help text
till reboot to next setup step

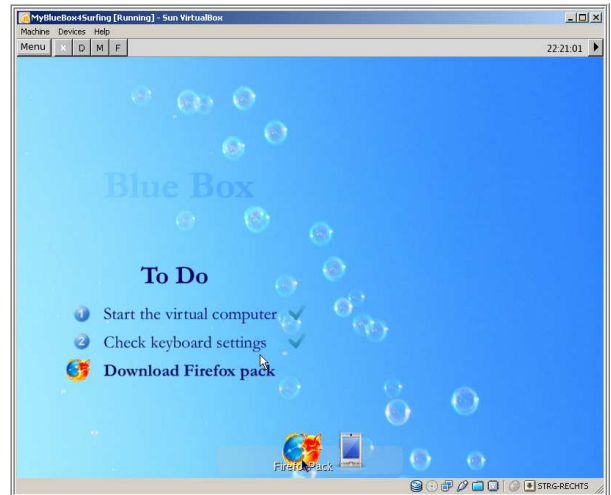

Install Software

After rebooting from the keyboard screen you get the software screen.

Again
click the bottom button
 and follow auto-help text
 till next reboot.



Setting Display

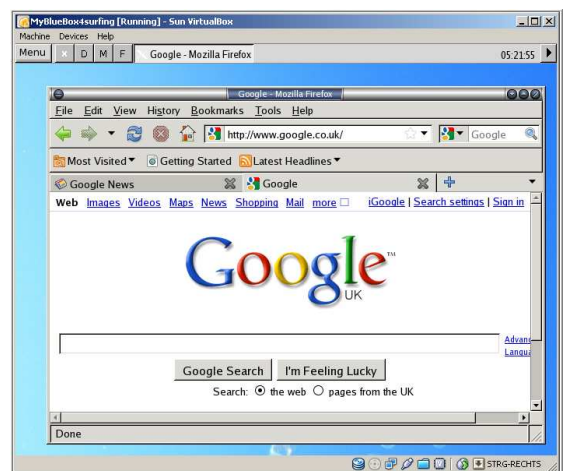
After rebooting from software screen the final working screen starts with resizing possibilities.

and the basic settings are done.

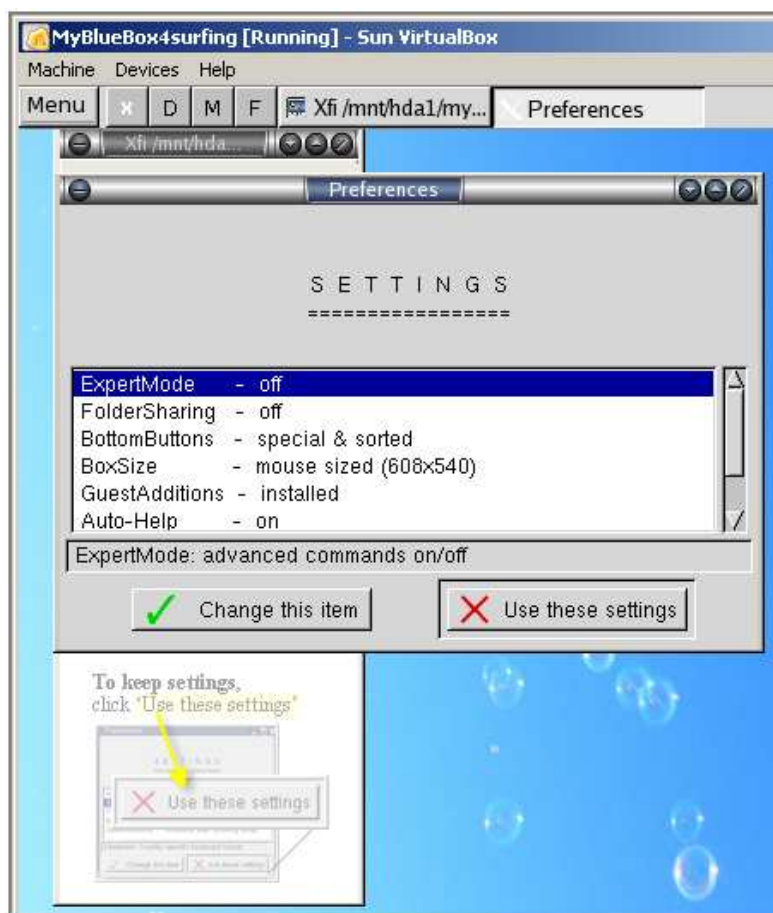
If not dropped, BlueBox will start a Firefox test:

... a list of settings available

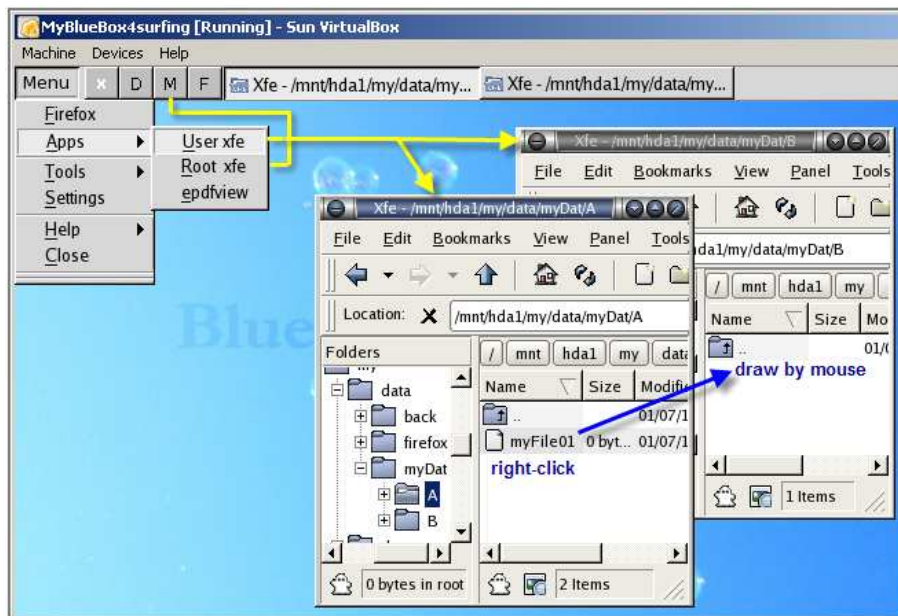
with helping hints⁴,
