Description

contmgr creates files:

```
|<Contacts><User>.pdf| for printing a phone booklet,
|<Contacts><User>.xml| for import in the Fritz box phonebook,
|<Contacts><User>.vcf| for import in iPad and Google contacts
```

in the directory CONTDIR (defined below), using the file Contacts.txt (a tab-separated export of Thunderbird's address book) in the same directory.

CONTDIR is the directory part of the environment variable CONTACTS, which must be defined and should contain the full path to your tab-separated export of Thunderbird's address book.

Without the --key option, <User> will be empty, with it, <User> is replaced with the argument of the --key option.

Without the --labels option, <Contacts> will be Contacts, with it, <Contacts> will be Labels.

If a key was given, then list only persons who have that key in the Screen Name field

Examples:

list all addresses, no company, include email, smallest font:

```

list Mia's addresses, no company, include email, remove areacode if 344:

```
contmgr -ea 344 -k Mia
```

list Anny's addresses, including email, fontsize 12, remove areacode if 345:

```
contmgr -e -a 345 -s 12 -k Anny
```

Change addresses and phone numbers only in TB's Personal Address Book.

Transfer to FritzBox:

```
contmgr -es9
```

produces:

- ~/Dropbox/Contacts/Contacts.xml, Use that file on the FritzBox to restore the phone book.
- ~/Dropbox/Contacts/Contacts.pdf, a printable address list, for your hand bag.
