Synopsis

```
clzip cleanedfile[.zip] otherfile[.zip]
```

Options:

```
-h, --help      print this help and exit  
-H, --Help      print full documentation via less and exit  
-V, --version   print version and exit
```

Description

clzip removes files that are contained in two zipped tar archives from the first archive. This may be useful if you make full backups from time to time: many files that occur in the first backup will also occur in following backups.

clzip considers two files to be identical if they have the same size and modification date and time.
